•Encouraging patients to remain active both mentally and physically, thinking about meal choices,

reminding to do exercises set by physios, planning activities for the day

Supporting patients:

·Sitting with palliative patients.

•Taking patients outside when appropriate to experience the hospital grounds.

·Assisting patients with the portable telephone and relaying telephone messages to patients.

·Assist with the preparation of mealtimes.

Accompanying patients to the day room.
